## WELCOME

*The staff at ZBC is looking forward to welcome you and introduce you to our school at arrival. Before arrival please read this information leaflet. If you have any questions, you are always welcome to contact us.*

### BEFORE ARRIVAL: INSURANCE

Remember to bring your insurance card (blue EU card) in case you need to visit a doctor. You must organize personal travel insurance to cover accidents and injuries as well as for any damages during training and theft of your personal belongings. ZBC are unfortunately not able to offer insurance cover for you in the training package.

### ARRIVAL

Arrival Sunday after 20:00 at ZBC - The Danish Meat Trade College, Maglegaardsvej 8, 4000 Roskilde.

At arrival to the College you will get assistance for installation in your room.

The College has approximately 200 students living in the hostel, of which the majority is Danish.

### ROOM FACILITIES



Accommodation is in shared two bedded rooms with bathroom and two desks/chairs.

Bed linen and towels is included in the fee for accommodation (changed every 14th day) as

well as working clothes, working shoes and equipment. Butchers, please bring warm underwear since it is cold in the cutting and deboning rooms. Hairdryer not available in the room.

You are obliged to – daily before study – clean up your room. This means, please:

- Make your own bed
- Switch of the light
- Air the room
- Close the window
- Put garbage in the garbage bin in the room. Large portions to be put in the garbage container outside the south entrance
- Violation can lead to extra expense for cleaning

Show consideration to others and be quiet from 23.00 o'clock.

### INTERNET

Wireless internet access at the hostel. Please bring your own laptop if possible. If you don't have a laptop you must bring a memory stick.

### DINING

Breakfast, lunch and dinner will take place in the canteen. After dining put up the chair.

It is not allowed to carry cups, dishes etc. from the canteen to the room.

### DAILY CLASS HOURS

Approx. 30 lessons per week from Monday to Friday between 08.00 and 15.15. Time schedule can though vary from day to day. You will get the final schedule at arrival.

## **SICKNESS**

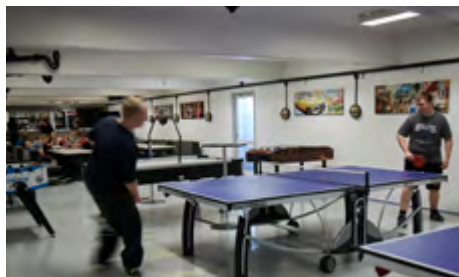
Please inform international department and your teacher personally 8 o'clock if you are sick.

## **WEEKENDS**

You will have access to a kitchen during the weekend. Food will be provided from the canteen, and you have to cook together with your classmates.

The Danish Students normally leave for home during the weekends.



## **WASHING AND DRYING**

We have a laundry, where you can wash and dry your clothes during your stay for a modest fee. Please contact the hostel staff.

We kindly ask you not to hang wet washing clothes in your room for drying – it can create mould and bad and unhealthy climate for you in your room.
